In view of reasons stated in the application, delay of 14 days in re-filing the review application is condoned.

RA-CW-302-2025

1. The petitioner has filed this review application in the shape of RA-CW-302-2025 seeking review of final order dated 30.04.2025 dismissing the writ petition (CWP-PIL-71-2025) filed as Public Interest Litigation, on the ground of delay and latches.

2. We have heard learned counsel for the applicant/petitioner at length.



3. Nothing has been brought on record or argued, which may compel us to change our view taken while dismissing the aforesaid writ petition, especially when nothing has been pointed out to demonstrate a case of palpable error, especially in the face of bar contained in Section 53 (5) of the Haryana Panchayati Raj Act, 1994, and also the absence of any reasonable explanation as to why the petitioner was sleeping over the cause since number of years before approaching the Ombudsman.

4. At this juncture, learned counsel for the applicant/petitioner prays for grant of liberty to raise such issues which were not raised before Ombudsman, which culminated into order dated 24.08.2024 (Annexure P-8).

5. With the aforesaid liberty, this Court declines interference in this review application and same is disposed of accordingly.
