1. This is the second petition filed under Section 528 BNSS, 2023 for quashing of FIR No.138 dated 17.12.2024 under Sections 126(2), 118(1), 109, 3(5) of BNS, 2023 registered at Police Station City-II, Malerkotla, District Malerkotla (Annexure P-1) and all the subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise dated 03.02.2025 (Annexure P-2).

2. Learned State counsel, at the very outset, on instructions from ASI Jaspal Singh, submits that the quashing of FIR (*supra*) on the basis of compromise cannot be allowed as the victim has suffered two stab wound injuries i.e. one in stomach and second on the head. As such, *prima facie*, offence under Section 307 is clearly made out and in terms of the judgment passed by Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in case of *The State of Madhya*

Pradesh vs. Laxmi Narayan and others, 2019 (5) SCC 688, quashing of FIR (*supra*) registered under Section 307 of IPC is not permissible.

3. In view of the above, present petition stands disposed of being not maintainable.
