1. Short reply by way of an affidavit of Sh. Kanwar Singh, Joint Director, Urban Local Bodies Department, Haryana on behalf of respondent Nos.1 and 2 has been filed in Court, the same is taken on record.

2. Learned counsel representing respondent No.3 on instructions submits that the petitioner may appear before the Commissioner, Municipal Corporation, Ambala, Ambala City on 20.02.2025 at 11.00 A.M. and an hearing shall be afforded to him. He also submits that speaking order on the cause of petitioner shall be passed within 02 weeks and a copy thereof shall be forwarded to the petitioner within a week thereafter.

3. In view of the aforesaid undertaking made on behalf of respondent No.3, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press the present petition.

4. Dismissed as not pressed. Rule stands discharged.

5. However, in case the needful in the aforesaid context is not done within the aforementioned period, as per the undertaking, the petitioner would be at liberty to seek revival of contempt petition and in that eventuality, the erring/concerned officer would be liable to pay a sum of Rs.50,000/- as cost(s) from his/her own pocket in favour of the petitioner towards litigation expenses, immediately i.e. on the first date of listing of revival application.
