Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner at the very outset makes a prayer for withdrawal of the instant contempt petition. Counsel submits that in compliance of the directions issued by this Court on 21.02.2014 in CWP No. 3359 of 2014, the salary has been released to the petitioner and as such compliance has been substantially made. Counsel submits that as regards claim of interest on the delayed release of salary, liberty be granted to approach the respondent-authorities/competent authority.

As per prayer made by learned counsel, the instant contempt petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous and not pressed. However, liberty is granted to the petitioner to approach the respondent-authorities/competent authority as regards award of interest on the delayed release of salary. If any such claim raised, the same would be considered strictly in accordance with law.
