The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 of B.N.S.S with a prayer to grant anticipatory bail to him in case FIR No.108, dated 08.04.2024, under Sections 380 and 457 of IPC (Section 411 of IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Civil Lines Sonipat, District Sonipat (Annexure P-1).
