1. Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for quashing of impugned FIR No.50 dated 03.10.2022 registered under Sections 419/420/120-B of IPC at Police Station Cyber Crime, Chandigarh (Annexure P-1) and all the subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise dated 07.10.2022 (Annexure P-2).

2. Learned Addl. P.P., UT Chandigarh opposes the prayer made by the petitioner on the ground that the FIR (*supra*) cannot be quashed on the basis of compromise as the complainants are the victim of the Cyber fraud and the complainant in the present case is 76 years old.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the present petition and seeks liberty to file a fresh petition after impleading all the stakeholders.

4. Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as prayed for.
