The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 528 of B.N.S.S with a prayer to direct the respondents to arrest the remaining accused as expeditiously as possible in FIR No.04, dated 04.01.2024, under Sections 379-B,307,34 of IPC and under Section 25/27 of the Arms Act and Sections 120-B,115,326 of IPC and 29/54/59 of Arms Act added later on, registered at Police Station Sadar Nakodar, District Jalandhar.

2. On advance notice, Mr. I.P.S Sabharwal, DAG, Punjab has appeared on behalf of official respondents and on instructions from ASI Major Singh submits that in the present case, two accused have been arrested and the challan has been presented against them on 02.04.2024. Now, the charge has also been ordered to be framed against two accused. He further contends that one of the accused namely Gurmeet Singh has been declared as a proclaimed offender in the present case and the process shall be initiated to attach the

properties owned by him.

3. In view of the statement made by learned State counsel, no further orders are required and the petition is accordingly, disposed of.
