**SANJAY VASHISTH, J.**

1. Present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C., seeking anticipatory bail in the event of his appearance before the learned trial Court in case FIR No.86 dated 16.06.2021, under Sections 420 and 406 IPC and Section 24 of Immigration Act, registered at Police Station Dakha, Ludhiana Rural, District Ludhiana.

2. On 04.11.2024, following order was passed:-

*“ Petitioner has approached this Court for grant of anticipatory bail and also against the order of declaring him proclaimed person in case FIR No.86 dated 16.06.2021 under Sections 420, 406 of IPC and Section 24 of Immigration Act, registered at Police Station Dakha, Ludhiana Rural, District Ludhiana.*

*Pursuant to order dated 11.07.2024, report has been received from Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court that the parties have settled the matter.*

*The petitioner was summoned under Section 319 Cr.PC. Let the petitioner to surrender before the trial Court within a week. In case of doing so, he shall be released on interim bail subject to his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.*

*Adjourned to 10.12.2024.*

*Interim order to continue.*

*A photocopy of this order be placed on the file of connected case.”*

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance to the order dated 04.11.2024, petitioner has already appeared on 11.11.2024 before the Court of learned Judicial Magistrate First Class, Ludhiana and has furnished the required bail bonds. Counsel further pointed out that in the order recorded by learned Judicial Magistrate First Class, name of petitioner is mentioned as Kuldeep Singh instead of Kuljit Singh. To substantiate his submission, counsel produced copy of the order dated 11.11.2024 in the Court today. Same is taken on record. Registry is directed to tag the same at appropriate place with the paper book. Thus, Counsel prays allowing of the present petition.

4. Heard learned counsel for the parties.

5. Keeping in view the fact that petitioner has already appeared before learned Judicial Magistrate First Class, Ludhiana and furnished the required bail bonds, present petition is allowed and ad-interim order dated 04.11.2024, passed by this Court is hereby made absolute.

6. Accordingly, petition stands disposed of.
