On 12.03.2025, following order was passed:-

“Learned counsel for the appellant states that the medial bills amounting to ₹3,38,982/- as verified by respondent No.3-Insurance Company, be given to the claimant-appellant and that the claimant-appellant would not press for the remaining medical bills.

Let an affidavit of the complainant-appellant be filed to this effect.

List on 01.04.2025.”

2. Pursuant to the aforesaid order, affidavit dated 25.03.2025 of the claimant has been filed, as per which the bills verified by respondent No.3-Insurance Company to the tune of ₹3,22,782/- are more than the bills attached by the deponent, i.e. claimant and that deponent, i.e. claimant accepted the bills as verified by the Insurance Company.

3. As such, the present appeal is hereby accepted to the extent that over and above the amount already allowed by the Tribunal, the appellant-claimant shall be entitled to the amount of Rs.3,38,982/- along with interest @ 6% per annum from the date of filing of the claim petition till its realization.
