1. The instant petition has been filed under Section 528 of BNSS, 2023 for quashing of impugned order dated 03.04.2018 (Annexure P-5), passed by learned JMIC Kaithal, whereby the petitioner has been declared as 'Proclaimed Person' in a complaint No.CIS-1079-2016 (Annexure P-1) under Section 138 of the NI Act, 1881 and the subsequent proceeding emanation from the order dated 03.04.2018.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner at the outset submits that the petitioner is ready and willing to appear and surrender before the trial Court. Hence, in the aforementioned facts and circumstances, petitioner be protected till his appearance before the learned trial Court and directions be given to the learned trial Court that his bail application, which he would be filing on his surrender, be decided expeditiously.

3. In view of the limited prayer made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is disposed of with directions to the petitioner to appear and surrender before the learned trial Court within 15 days from today. Till then, no coercive steps be taken against the petitioner.

4. It is made clear that in case the petitioner fails to surrender before the trial Court within 15 days from today, this order shall be of no avail to him thereafter. In case, on appearance and surrender, the petitioner moves an application for bail, the trial Court shall make earnest efforts to decide it expeditiously, in accordance with law.
