1. Prayer in the present petition, filed under Section 482 of the BNSS, 2023 (erstwhile Section 438 of the Cr.P.C.), is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in a case FIR No.130 dated 27.06.2024, registered under Sections 302, 307, 447, 511, 148, 149, 120-B of IPC (Sections 411 & 201 IPC added lateron) and Sections 25, 27/54/59 of the Arms Act, at Police Station Lopoke, District Amritsar Rural.
2. Status report by way of affidavit of Inderjit Singh, PPS, DSP, Sub-Division Rajasansi, Amritsar (Rural), filed in the Court today, is taken on record.
3. After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner prays for withdrawal of the present petition, with liberty to surrender before the trial Court and file an appropriate bail application.
4. Allowed to do so.
5. Dismissed as withdrawn, with liberty as prayed for. If the petitioner surrenders before the trial Court within a period of seven days from today and files an appropriate application for bail, then the trial Court would decide the same expeditiously, in accordance with law.
