Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.102 dated 04.07.2024, under Sections 21 & 29 of NDPS Act at Police Station Special Task Force, District STF Wing.

Vide order dated 12.08.2024, while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that pursuant to order dated 12.08.2024, petitioner has joined the investigation and as such his interim bail may be made absolute.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Bhupinder Singh, affirmed the fact that the petitioner has joined the



investigation and he is no more required for further investigation.
