1. This execution second appeal has been filed by the objectors, who have purchased the property during the pendency of the suit and in violation of injunction order passed in a recovery suit.
2. The Executing Court ordered the attachment of the property against which the appellants filed objection petition on the ground that they are bonafide purchasers.
3. Both the courts held that the appellants have purchased the property in infringement of the injunction order and hence they cannot claim to be a bonafide purchaser.
4. The learned counsel representing the appellants submits that an amount of Rs.6,00,000/- has already been deposited in the Executing Court which has been released to the decree holder.
5. Only the attachment of the property has been ordered. The appellants still have the liberty to satisfy the decree.



6. Keeping in view the aforesaid facts and discussion, no ground to interfere is made out.

7. Dismissed.

8. All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
