SURYA PARTAP SINGH, J. (Oral):

1. This is a petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, seeking for setting aside of order dated 28.01.2025, passed by the learned Sessions Judge, Moga in a case arising out of FIR No.100 dated 04.09.2020 under Sections 307, 336, 325, 148, 149 IPC and 25, 27 of Arms Act, Police Station Kot Ise Khan, District Moga. By virtue of above mentioned order the warrant of arrest of the petitioner have been issued.

2. The petitioner who had jumped the bail has approached this Court.

3. Vide order dated 07.03.2025 a direction was issued to the petitioner to appear before the learned trial Court within four weeks. In the abovementioned eventuality the learned trial Court was directed to admit the petitioner to interim bail.

4. It has been submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that in compliance with the above mentioned direction the petitioner has appeared



before the learned trial Court and he is participating in the trial. This fact is also mentioned in the reply filed by the learned State counsel.

5. Keeping in view the aforesaid facts and circumstances, the present petition is hereby allowed and the order dated 07.03.2025 granting interim bail to the petitioner is hereby made absolute.
