SANJIV BERRY, J. (ORAL)

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that in compliance of the order dated 07.05.2025 passed by this Court, the petitioner has deposited an amount of Rs.2 lacs in the shape of FDR in favour of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Sonapat and has placed on record the copy of the order dated 13.05.2025 which is taken on record.

2. By way of present petition filed under Section 482 BNSS, 2023, the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR (Annexure P-1) as under: -

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance to the order dated 07.05.2025, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

4. During the course of hearing on 07.05.2025, following order had been passed: -

“ ASI Surjit Singh, Investigation Officer of the case is present in Court Today.

2. Heard.

3. Considering the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner and learned State counsel and after perusing the record, it is deemed appropriate that the petitioner should join the investigation first before deciding the present petition on merits.

4. In these circumstances, without commenting on the merits, the petitioner is directed to join the investigation within 07 days from today and in the event of his arrest, he is ordered to be released on interim bail on his furnishing personal/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer/Investigating Officer. He shall also abide by conditions as envisaged under Section 482(2) of BNSS, 2023.

5. The petitioner is also directed to deposit an FDR amounting to ₹2 lacs favoring Chief Judicial Magistrate, Sonapat within 7 days, which will be kept in safe custody in the said Court and be not encashed till further orders.

6. List on 26.05.2025.

7. Investigating Officer of the case to remain present in Court along with record on the date fixed.”



5. Learned State counsel on instructions received from ASI Sukhdeev informs the Court that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is neither required for further investigation nor for any custodial interrogation.

6. Keeping in view the above submissions made by learned State counsel and the fact that the petitioner had joined the investigation consequent to the order dated 07.05.2025 passed by this Court, interim bail granted vide order dated 07.05.2025 is hereby confirmed, subject to conditions as envisaged under Section 482(2) of BNSS. Further the petitioner is directed to join investigation as and when required in future by way of written notice for such purpose to be served by Investigating Officer of this case upon the petitioner; he will not tamper with the evidence nor will influence the witnesses and will not leave the country without prior permission of the Court.

7. The petition stands allowed.

8. It is made clear that anything contained hereinabove shall not be construed to be an expression of opinion on the merits of the case.
