The instant revision petition has been preferred by the petitioner for setting-aside the judgment of conviction and order on quantum of sentence dated 26.07.2007 passed by the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Jalandhar, in a complaint filed under Section 276C(2) of the Income Tax Act, 1961, for the Assessment Year, 1983-84, as well as the judgment dated 06.11.2008 passed by the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Jalandhar.
