1. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226 and 227 of the Constitution of India is seeking direction to respondent to correct his date of birth.

2. The petitioner is claiming that his correct date of birth is 15.06.1971 whereas it is wrongly recorded as 15.06.1967. He was regularized as Mali on 01.10.1993. He, time and again submitted documents for correction of his date of birth but to no avail. The respondent has also issued identity card with correct date of birth.

3. Mr. Arvind Seth, Advocate, who on advance notice is present in Court, submits that competent authority would consider claim of the petitioner and pass an appropriate order after examining all the documents submitted by him.

4. Mr. Bansal agrees to the aforesaid arrangement.

5. In the wake of statement of both sides, instant petition stands disposed of. Let the needful be done within 4 weeks from today.
