1. Petitioners have approached this Court for directing that the investigation of FIR No.318 dated 14.10.2023, under Sections 21-C, 25, 29 of the NDPS Act, 1985, registered at Police Station Special Task Force (STF), Amritsar be carried out fairly and impartially by some senior officer of the rank of IPS of the Crime Branch or any other independent agency and further for directing the respondents to ensure that the family members of the petitioners are not unnecessarily harassed.

2. Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Harpal Singh, at the outset, submits that the trial in the present case is at the advanced stage and out of 15 prosecution witnesses, 05 witnesses already stand examined.

3. In view of the submissions made by learned State counsel, the present petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioners to pursue their remedies before the trial Court as available to them under the law.
