**AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J.(ORAL)**

Counsel for the State points out that the petitioner has not submitted the option on revision of pension.

Counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner will appear before the District Education Officer (Secondary Education), Jalandhar, where he will submit her option as may be required by the respondents, as has been objected to by the Accountant General, Punjab.

On doing so, the benefits which the petitioner is entitled to will be released by the respondents. The process with regard to the release of the pension as per the option given by the petitioner will be completed within a period of six weeks and arrears shall be released to the petitioner within a further period of two weeks.

With the abovesaid directions, the present contempt petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to revive the contempt petition, in case of default on the part of the respondents.
