1. The present petition has been filed under Section 528 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (for short-'BNSS') seeking issuance of direction to the respondents to look into the complainant/representations dated 04.01.2025 and 28.02.2025 (Annexures P-1 and P-2, respectively).

2. At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner restricts his prayer to the extent to which prayer has been made to decide legal notice/representation dated 28.02.2025 filed by him before the Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana as well as before the Senior Superintendent of Police, Khanna (Annexure P-2), raising his grievances as mentioned in the present petition but the same has not yet been considered and no action has been taken thereon. He further submitted that at this stage, the petitioner would be satisfied if appropriate directions are issued to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Khanna to decide the aforesaid representation filed by the petitioners and take necessary action thereon.
