NAMIT KUMAR, J. (ORAL)

1. Present petition has been filed under Section 401 Cr.PC impugning the order dated 01.06.2019 passed by learned Principal Judge, Family Court, Jalandhar, whereby the respondents have been granted maintenance of a sum of Rs.7,000/- per month along with Rs.5,000/- as litigation expenses.

2. On 19.10.2019, the following order was passed:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner has argued at length and when this Court is not inclined to interfere in the case, he restricts his argument to settle the dispute with the respondent No.1-wife and respondent No.2-minor son so as to take them with him.

For this limited extent that the petitioner is ready to take the wife and child to the matrimonial home, notice of motion be issued.

Notice re: condonation of delay in filing the petition as well.

Process Dasti only.

The petitioner and respondent No.1 are directed to appear before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this



Court on 13.11.2019. However, the petitioner shall pay a sum of Rs.15,000/- to respondent No.1 on her causing appearance before the aforesaid Centre as litigation expenses, which shall be a condition precedent for initiation of mediation proceedings.

For awaiting report, list on 17.12.2019.

It is made clear that notice of motion is being issued in this case for limited purpose enabling the family to stay together, otherwise no interference is warranted with the impugned order passed by the family Court, whereby maintenance has been granted to the respondents.”

3. As per report of the Mediator, the mediation has failed.
4. Faced with this situation, learned counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the present petition.
5. Dismissed as withdrawn.
6. Pending application(s), if any, also stand disposed of.
