Prayer in the present petition is for quashing the FIR No. 180 dated 09.10.2006 under Sections 323, 324, 341, 148 and 149 of Indian Penal Code (offences under Sections 325, 326 of IPC added later on) registered at Police Station Malerkotla, Sangrur (Now District Malerkotla) and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise dated 28.02.2024 and affidavit dated 19.03.2024 (Annexures P-2 and P-3).

Learned State counsel at the very outset submits that FIR(supra) was registered against 07 accused persons and only 02 namely Gurjit Singh and Surjit Singh have approached this Court seeking quashing of FIR(supra) and further one more injured Paramjit Kaur has not been impleaded as a party and in view of the judgment passed by Division Bench of this Court, the partial compromise is not permissible.

Therefore, in view of the above, the present petition is dismissed, being not maintainable. However, liberty is granted to the petitioners to file a fresh petition seeking quashing of FIR(supra) on the basis of compromise after impleading all the stake holders.
