1. Prayer made in the present petition for directing the respondents to provide a compassionate appointment to the petitioner.
2. Learned counsel submits that the premise of the speaking order is that at the time when although petitioner had passed away, he was not in service. In this context, respondents have completely overlooked vital aspect of the matter that it was in a *lis* at his hands in CWP-16191-1997 that his order of dismissal was set aside on 23.12.2016, which however, could not be implemented on account of the aforesaid fact.
3. The aforesaid facts having been brought out, during the course of hearing, learned State counsel, on instructions, states that the respondents shall reconsider and decide the matter afresh taking note of the aforesaid submission within a period of 4 months, which this Court has no reason to believe the authorities would not address in a just, fair and reasonable manner.
4. The aforesaid satisfies the learned counsel for the petitioner.

5. The matter stands disposed of accordingly and if the petitioner is found entitled, grant the benefit forthwith. Needless to say, if the orders are adverse to his interest, the same may be passed after granting opportunity of hearing to him and shall contain reasons, whereupon he shall be free to seek legal redress thereupon.
