Prayer in this petition is for initiation of contempt proceedings against the respondent for not complying the order dated 12.11.2024 (Annexure P-1) passed by a co-ordinate Bench of this Court in CWP-14315-2013 titled as "Sunita Rani vs. State of Haryana and others".

At the very outset, it is submitted by learned Senior Counsel for the petitioner that order dated 12.11.2024 (Annexure P-1) has been complied with and a Speaking Order dated 25.3.2025 has been passed by the respondent-Director General Elementary Education, Haryana, Panchkula.



Learned counsel for the respondent-State also submits that necessary compliance has been made, while passing a speaking order dated 25.3.2025 by the respondent; thus, no cause survives in the present petition.

Copy of the aforesaid order dated 25.3.2025 produced by the learned counsel for the respondent-State is taken on record. Registry to tag/paginate the same at appropriate place in the paper-book.

In view of the above, learned Senior Counsel for the petitioner does not press the present petition any further.

Dismissed as not pressed.

The petitioner would be at liberty to challenge the aforesaid speaking order dated 25.3.2025 as per rules.
