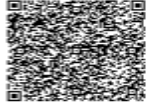

VIKRAM AGGARWAL, J. (ORAL)

CWP-27791-2019 was disposed of by a coordinate Bench of this Court vide order dated 20.12.2023, along with CWP-25310-2019, and the following directions were passed:-

“[9] In view of the discussion made hereinabove, all these writ petitions are allowed and LAC-respondent No.2 is directed to grant compensation to the petitioners as per the final determination by the Hon'ble Apex Court, besides all other statutory benefits and interest thereupon in accordance with section 34 of the 1894 Act. However, it is clarified that keeping in mind the fact that petitioner(s) did not approach this Court promptly and with the purpose that unnecessary burden is not placed on the State, petitioners would not be entitled for interest on the enhanced compensation from the date of final



determination by the Hon'ble Apex Court till they approached this Court.”

2. Concededly, the order referred to above has been complied with.

3. During the course of the instant contempt petition, certain orders were passed by a coordinate Bench as regards deposit of compensation lying with the Land Acquisition Collector(s) and it was directed that the amount be deposited with the concerned Reference Court(s).

3.1 The Court had been informed that the process is underway and is being undertaken in the right earnest.

4. Since the order dated 20.12.2023 stands complied with, no further directions are required to be passed by this Court, at this stage.

5. The contempt petition is accordingly disposed of.

6. Rule is discharged.

7. Pending applications, if any, shall also stand disposed of.
