MAHESH GROVER.J.

The petitioner who appears in person does not dispute that all amounts have been cleared to his satisfaction. There is, however, a minor grievance which he has expressed in the reply to the application dated 25.11.2013, where in para No.4 the petitioner states that the amount comes to Rs.1,11,092/-approximately, whereas the respondents have calculated it to be Rs.81,500/-, a shortfall of about Rs.30,000/-. Since the order of this court now stands largely complied with, the rule against the respondents deserves to be discharged. The petitioner would be at liberty to approach the respondents. The respondents will take notice of this discrepancy and respond to the petitioner within six weeks from today and apprise the petitioner regarding this discrepancy which he has pointed out. A speaking order would be passed in this regard so as to satisfy the concerns of the petitioner.

The petition is disposed of at this stage as having been satisfied with the aforesaid directions.
