1. This is the second petition filed by the petitioner for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.011 dated 29.01.2020 under Sections 22/29/61/85 of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 registered at Police Station Tanda, District Hoshiarpur.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the prosecution witnesses are not appearing before the trial Court and because of this the custody period of the petitioner is being delayed.
2. However, learned State counsel has submitted that the earlier petition bearing CRM-M No.62769-2024 filed by the petitioner for grant of regular bail was declined on 18.12.2024.
3. This Court does not find any change in circumstances which would entitle the petitioner for grant of regular bail. Hence, the present petition is dismissed, at this stage. However, the prosecution is directed to produce the witnesses before the trial Court and the trial Court would examine the same, at the earliest.
