1. On 07.08.2023, a Coordinate Bench of this Court was pleased
to pass the following order:-

*“Present: Mr. Vishva Nath Sharma, Advocate
for the petitioner.*

*Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted
that due to financial crunches, he was not able to pay the
decreetal amount which as per his calculation is made out
to be around Rs.36,00,000/- as on date. However, he further
submitted that the petitioner is ready to pay the aforesaid
amount, if, some reasonable time is granted by staying the
execution proceedings. To show his bona fide, the petitioner
is ready to bring the demand draft of half of the amount i.e.
Rs.18,00,000/- before this Court on the next date of
hearing, payable to the decree holder.*

Notice of motion.

*The petitioner is directed through dasti process as
well as through the counsel representing the decree holder
before the Executing Court. On the next date of hearing, the
petitioner would bring the demand draft of amount of*
