committing forgery of petitioner's signatures on the Consent Form for issuance of passport to their minor son, namely Abhayveer Singh Nagra.

1.1 A further prayer has been made for directing the official respondents to decide representations dated 21.02.2025 (Annexures P-10 to P-12) and legal notices dated 03.03.2025 (Annexures P-13 and P-14), in a time bound manner.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner, at the outset, submits that he may be permitted to withdraw the instant writ petition with liberty to the petitioner to avail his other remedies, in accordance with law.

3. Keeping in view the aforesaid submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the present writ petition is dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty aforesaid.
