Prayer in this petition is for initiation of contempt proceedings against the respondents for not complying the order dated 19.3.2025 (Annexure P-1) passed by a co-ordinate Bench of this Court in CWP-7515 of 2025 titled as “Jaspreet Singh vs. State of Punjab and others” vide which the petition was disposed of on the basis of statement made by learned counsel for the State to the effect that “*in case, the representation dated 20.08.2024 (Annexure P-10) has been received in the office of the concerned authorities and the same is still pending consideration with the authorities concerned, the same will be decided by the competent authority within a period of four weeks of the receipt of certified copy of this order by passing an appropriate speaking order and in case, the petitioner is found*



entitled for grant of any relief, the same will be granted to him, otherwise due reasons for not accepting the claim of the petitioner will be mentioned in the speaking order.”

At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that since the order dated 19.3.2025 (Annexure P-1) has been complied with by the respondents, he may be permitted to withdraw the present contempt petition.

Permitted to do so.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
