CM-9641-CWP-2025:

Prayer in the present application is for withdrawal of the main writ petition, bearing CWP No.15023 of 2025, with liberty to file fresh one with better particulars, as there are certain typographical mistakes in the said writ petition.

During the course of hearing, learned counsel appearing for the applicants/petitioners has not disputed that as against the orders impugned in the main writ petition, the remedy of revision under Section 16 of the Haryana Land Revenue Act is available to the applicants/petitioners.

Accordingly, it is prayed that the main writ petition (CWP-15023-2025), which is otherwise fixed for 23.07.2025, may be taken up on Board today itself and permitted to be withdrawn with liberty to the petitioners to avail the alternative remedy of revision before the learned Divisional Commissioner.

Keeping in view the aforesaid submissions made by learned counsel for the applicants/petitioners as well as the reasons mentioned in the present application, the same is allowed. The writ petition, bearing CWP No.15023 of 2025, is taken up on Board today itself and the same is permitted to be withdrawn with the liberty aforesaid.
