None for the non-applicant/petitioner.

This is an application under Section 24 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, for grant of maintenance pendente lite. The trial Court granted maintenance to the applicant @ Rs.10,000/- per month. The applicant alleges that the petitioner is having a take home salary of Rs.48000/- per month and has appended a salary certificate along with the application. Although a reply has been filed but categoric denial to the salary slip does not manifest itself therefrom.

There is no representation on behalf of non-applicant.

We would therefore presume that the salary certificate appended to the application is correct and proceed therefore to determine the amount of maintenance pendente lite. The applicant has a minor school going son and she herself is a home maker with no source of income. We are thus of the opinion that the ends of justice would meet if the maintenace pendente lite to the extent of Rs.20,000/- per month is granted to the applicant and her school going son from the date of filing of the present application.

Application stands allowed.
