SUVIR SEHGAL, J.(ORAL)

1. By way of instant petition filed under Article 227 of the Constitution of India, petitioners have sought issuance of appropriate direction to the Rent Controller, Patiala to decide the eviction petition, Annexure P1, filed by the petitioners – landlord under Section 20 (P) of the Punjab Rent Act, 1995.

2. After addressing for some time and upon being confronted with the observations by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in **M. Gopalakrishnan & Ors. Versus Pasumpon Muthuramalingam & Anr., 2022 LiveLaw (SC) 298**, counsel for the petitioners seeks and is granted permission to withdraw the present petition with liberty to take recourse to the remedy available to him under law by approaching the Rent Controller, Patiala.
