1. The instant petition has been filed for initiation of contempt proceedings against the respondents for alleged willful disobedience of the interim order dated 14.02.2022 (Annexure P-1), passed by the Writ Court in CWP-20384-2021.

2. Status-cum-Compliance report filed by way of affidavit dated 05.09.2025 of Mr. Naveen Kumar, HCS, Estate Officer, HSVP, Faridabad, is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to the opposite counsel. Registry to tag the same at appropriate place.

3. Learned counsel for respondent Nos.1 & 2 submits that sanction has been accorded for a sum of Rs.4,57,77,340/- as per the sanction order dated 28.08.2025 (Annexure R-1) issued by the Administrator, HSVP, Faridabad. It is further submitted that even



payment of Rs.16,24,45,307/- on account of enhanced compensation awarded by the Reference Court has been deposited before the Additional District Judge, Faridabad and the same has also been uploaded on the *I-Pay portal* on 01.09.025 (Annexure R-2).

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he has already filed an execution petition before the Executing Court, which is still pending.

5. In view of the above facts and circumstances, nothing survives in the present petition and the same is accordingly disposed of.

6. Needless to mention that the payment of the landowners would be released by the Executing Court, in due course, as there is no objection on behalf of the respondents.

7. However, the petitioner shall be at liberty to file an application for revival of the petition, if any grievance still subsists.

8. Pending miscellaneous applications, if any, shall stand disposed of.
