This contempt petition has been filed pleading wilful disobedience of order dated 1.3.2019 passed in CWP No. 5696 of 2019.

The operational part of the order is reproduced below:

"This petition is being disposed of keeping in view letter dated 02.02.2019 issued by the Chief Secretary, Government of Haryana that in case of vacant posts, regular candidates are not available, the petitioners shall be taken back in service on the vacant posts and they will be replaced only by regularly selected candidates or if their work and conduct is not found satisfactory."

Pursuant to notice of motion, reply dated 18.10.2019 was filed.

The respondent has pleaded that the order alleged to be violated was modified in a review application filed by the respondent. Vide order dated 13.9.2019 the earlier order was recalled and it was observed that the petitioners can continue to work as Apprentice under the Apprentice Act, 1961 and shall not be governed by the provisions of letter dated 2.2.2019. It is further pleaded that the regular selection of Group 'D' employees through

Haryana Staff Selection Commission, has been made and thereafter, the petitioners were relieved.

Learned counsel for the petitioners is not in a position to contradict the said factual aspect.

There is no cause of action surviving for pursuing the present contempt petition.

Dismissed.
