1. Present revision petition has been filed under Article 227 of the Constitution of India for setting aside the order dated 23.05.2024 passed by the Ld. Civil Judge (Junior Division), Gurugram, whereby the evidence of the petitioner was closed by Court order and order dated 18.03.2025 passed by Ld. Civil Judge (Junior Division), Gurugram, vide which the application filed by the petitioner for setting aside order dated 23.05.2024 was dismissed.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that it was due to unavoidable circumstances that evidence could not be lead and one last opportunity be granted to the petitioner to examine the witnesses and to lead evidence.

3. I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and perused the whole record of the case.

4. A perusal of the record shows that though the petitioner was granted opportunities to lead evidence from the year 2020 till 2024, whereas



justice demands that one last opportunity be granted to the petitioner to lead evidence subject to payment of Rs.5,000/- as costs to be deposited by the petitioner with the District Legal Services Authority concerned.

5. In view of the above, revision petition is allowed and order dated 23.05.2024 passed by the learned Civil Judge (Junior Division), Gurugram, is set aside. The next date before the Ld. Civil Judge (Junior Division), Gurugram is stated to be 14.08.2025. Ld. Civil Judge (Junior Division), Gurugram is directed to grant one effective opportunity to the petitioner to lead his evidence on 14.08.2025 itself.
