The petition has been filed *inter alia* seeking a writ of *certiorari* quashing the letter dated 29.10.2024, Annexure P-9, whereby the third respondent has refused to accept the petitioner's resignation submitted on 09.08.2024.

2. Learned State counsel, on instructions, has referred to an order dated 18.03.2025 passed by the third respondent accepting the petitioner's resignation which is to the following effect:

Therefore, it become clear from the above given position that she does not want to continue her services. Hence three months advance notice of resignation dated 09.08.2024 and subsequent resignation w.e.f. 08.11.2024 (A.N.) is hereby accepted after completion of three months of advance notice as per her request. Her final salary & benefit will be processed according to applicable rules and regulations.



3. In view thereof, learned counsel for the petitioner has no objection to the petition being disposed of with a direction to the third respondent/Director, Kalpana Chawla Govt. Medical College to release due benefits, in terms of the order dated 18.03.2025, to the petitioner within a period of eight weeks.

4. Ordered accordingly.
