1. Petitioner prays for grant of pre-arrest bail in FIR No.43 dated 25.03.2025 registered under Sections 21/27-A/29/61 of NDPS Act at Police Station City Shri Hargobindpur, Police District Batala, District Gurdaspur.
2. While granting the concession of interim anticipatory bail by this Court on 05.05.2025, the following contentions were noticed by this Court and the same have been reproduced below:-

*“Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner was not named in the FIR and has been nominated as an accused on the basis of disclosure statement suffered by co-accused Jugraj Singh. He next submits that the allegations levelled by the complainant in the present FIR are highly unbelievable and the petitioner had no concern with the allegations. The petitioner was neither arrested at the spot nor any recovery was ever made from him. Learned counsel also submits that the petitioner was never involved in any other*

*criminal case and is a first offender”.*

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has reiterated the submissions and further submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation may not be required.

4. Learned State counsel also submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no longer required for further investigation.

5. In view of the above statement made by learned counsel for the parties, the interim order dated 05.05.2025 is made absolute. The petitioner shall continue to join the investigation, as and when called by the Investigating Officer. The petitioner shall also abide by the conditions as specified under Section 482 (2) of B.N.S.S.
