Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that contempt proceedings be initiated against the respondent(s) for not complying the order dated 29.5.2023 (Annexure P-1) passed by a Division Bench of this Court in CWP-PIL-46-2023 titled as “Jai Gopal Dhiman vs. State of Punjab and others”, vide which the direction was issued to the respondents-authorities “....to consider and deal with the representations submitted by the petitioner and pass appropriate orders thereon, in accordance with law. This Court is sanguine that as assured by the learned State counsel, the needful shall be done within the time indicated above.....”.

In pursuance of notice of motion issued by this Court, learned State counsel has already filed Reply dated 24.5.2024 in the



Registry, which is annexed with the file. The said Reply is ordered to be taken on record. Learned counsel for the State undertakes to supply copy of the said reply to learned counsel for the petitioner. Registry to tag/paginate the same at appropriate place in the paper-book.

Learned counsel for the respondents-State also submits that necessary compliance has been made while passing a Speaking Order dated 16.2.2024 (Annexure R-1/T); thus, no cause survives in the present petition.

In view of the above, no further orders are required to be passed in the present petition, the same is **disposed of** accordingly.
