Prayer in the present petition is for initiation of contempt proceedings against the respondent for not complying the order dated 22.1.2025 (Annexure P-1) passed by a co-ordinate Bench of this Court in CWP-1650-2025 titled as “Ram Mehar vs. State of Haryana and another”, vide which the petition was disposed with direction that “...the Competent Authority of Haryana Staff Selection to consider and decide the representation dated 20.11.2024 (Annexure P-12) by passing a reasoned and speaking order after affording an opportunity of hearing to the respective parties within a period of one month of the receipt of certified copy of this order.”

Learned counsel for the respondent-State, on instructions from Mr. Chirag Aggarwal, ADA, HSSC submits that necessary



compliance has been made, while passing a speaking order dated 29.5.2025 by the respondent; thus, no cause survives in the present petition.

Copy of the aforesaid order dated 29.5.2025 produced by the learned counsel for the respondent-State is taken on record. Registry to tag/paginate the same at appropriate place in the paper-book.

In view of the above, the present petition is **disposed of**.

The petitioner would be at liberty to challenge the aforesaid speaking order dated 29.5.2025 as per law.
