1. By way of this common order, the aforementioned three cases are being disposed of, as same are arising out of same FIR.

2. Present petitions have been filed under Section 482 of the BNSS, 2023 /438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner(s), who has been booked in a criminal case arising out of First Information Report, as detailed hereabove.

2. In one of the anticipatory bail petition i.e. CRM-M-36220-2024, on 30.07.2024 the co-ordinate Bench of this Court has passed following order:-

*“ Notice of motion for 14.11.2024.*

*Meanwhile, in the event of arrest, the petitioner be released on interim bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when*

*called upon to do so and co-operate with the Investigating Officer and shall also abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”*

Thereupon, similar order(s) dated 31.07.2024 and 06.08.2024 were passed in CRM-M-36444-2024 & CRM-M-37934-2024 respectively.

3. At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioners contend that in compliance of the orders dated 30.07.2024, 31.07.2024 and 06.08.2024, passed by the co-ordinate Bench of this Court, the petitioners have joined the investigation, and have fully co-operated. Thus, pray for confirmation of the interim bail and to allow the present petitions.

4. On instructions from SI Rajender Kumar, learned State counsel confirms the said averment and submits that the custodial interrogation of the petitioners would not be required now for the purpose of investigation.

5. Heard learned counsel for the parties.

6. Since the petitioners have joined the investigation and custodial interrogation is also no more required, present petitions are allowed and ad-interim orders dated 30.07.2024, 31.07.2024 and 06.08.2024, passed by the co-ordinate Bench of this Court are hereby made absolute.

However, petitioners shall continue to join the investigation as and when required to do so and abide by all the terms and conditions laid down under Section 482(2) of BNSS, 2023.

7. Accordingly, petitions stand disposed of.
