On the last date of hearing i.e. 30.01.2018, when the case came up for hearing, learned counsel for the respondents had submitted that all encroachments have been removed and the counsel for the petitioner had sought time to seek verification thereof. Today he has filed an affidavit of the petitioner but all these alleged encroachments, which have been pointed out by the petitioner, relate to inside the Air Conditioned Market, Civil Lines, near Durga Mata Mandir, Ludhiana.

That would not fall within the ambit of the order passed by the Division Bench.

In view of the statement which was earlier recorded by this Court, the present contempt as of now has been rendered infructuous.

The same is disposed of as such.

Rule issued to the respondents stands discharged.
