SHEEL NAGU, CHIEF JUSTICE (Oral)

1. This PIL raises the public cause of certain revered Hindu symbols being used as Trademark by Shree Baidyanath Ayurved Bhawan (respondent No.5).

2. A complaint seems to have been lodged by petitioner initially before the Ministry of Home Affairs, Government of India, which was forwarded to the Ministry of Commerce & Industry vide office memorandum dated 28.02.2025 (Annexure P-7). The Ministry of Commerce & Industry, vide letter dated 08.04.2025 (Annexure P-8), with copy to the petitioner, sought certain information from Under Secretary, Department of Consumer



Affairs, Emblems and Names; and Deputy Secretary, Ministry of Home Affairs.

3. It appears that respondents No. 1 and 2 are looking into grievance of the petitioner and, therefore, this Court would not like to come in way of said process of consideration by respondents No.1 and 2.

4. In view of above, present petition stands disposed of with liberty to the petitioner that in case, her grievance does not get redressed, she can re-visit the Court.
