1. Instant petition is preferred under Section 482 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.82 dated 20.04.2025 under Sections 21 & 29 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, registered at Police Station City 1, Abohar, District Fazilka.
