The present revision petition has been filed for setting aside the order dated 13.2.2025 (Annexure P-8) passed by the learned Civil Judge (Sr. Divn.), Chandigarh whereby the application filed by the petitioners under Order 7 Rule 11 CPC has been dismissed.

Vide order dated 08.4.2025, while issuing Notice of Motion, further proceedings before the learned trial Court had been stayed by this Court.

It is submitted by learned Senior Counsel for the petitioners that the present revision petition has been rendered infructuous as the respondent has filed an application before the Civil Judge (Sr. Divn.), Chandigarh seeking permission to withdraw the main Guardian Petition instituted by the respondents. Learned Senior Counsel has handed over a



copy of the order dated 15.4.2025 passed by the learned Civil Judge (Sr. Divn.), Chandigarh, in which, reference is made to the said application filed by the respondents. The said copy of the order is taken on record. It is submitted that however, the said application for withdrawal is not being considered by the learned trial Court in view of the fact that vide order dated 08.4.2025 this Court has stayed further proceedings before the learned trial Court.

Ms. Avin K. Sandhu, Advocate has put in appearance and files Power of Attorney on behalf of respondent No.1(a). The same is taken on record. Learned counsel for respondent No.1 admits that the aforesaid application has been filed by respondent No.1 before the learned trial Court seeking withdrawal of the main Guardian Petition.

Learned Senior Counsel for the petitioner prays that therefore in view of the statement made by learned counsel for the respondent No.1 praying for withdrawal of the main Guardian Petition, the present revision petition may be disposed of.

Heard.

In view of the above, the present petition is **disposed of** in terms of the statement made by learned counsel for respondent No.1.
