The jurisdiction of this Court has been invoked under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus seeking direction to respondents No.2 & 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners which is under imminent danger at the hands of respondents No.4 to 7.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Jasjit Singh Rattu, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State, who has produced a speaking order passed by SHO, Police Station Naya Gaon, dated Nil, wherein it has been stated by the petitioners that they are not under any threat from anyone, do not require any security, and are currently living happily. A copy of the speaking order has been furnished to learned counsel for the petitioners.

In light of the above, learned counsel for the petitioners does not want to press the instant petition any further and prays for withdrawal of the same.

Prayer is accepted.

The present petition stands dismissed as withdrawn.

However, the petitioners would be at liberty to file appeal, as is stipulated in the Standard Operating Procedure as per law, in case of any grievance left after passing of the speaking order.
