JAGMOHAN BANSAL, J. (Oral)

1. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226 and 227 of the Constitution of India is seeking direction to respondent to appoint him on the vacant post of Network Supervisor.

2. On 21.01.2025, the following order was passed:-

“The petitioner claims that he belongs to General category but is a physically challenged person. He had applied for the post meant for physically challenged persons. There are two posts. One post is occupied. There are two candidates, thus, there is no question of cut off. The respondent has wrongly rejected his claim.

Learned State counsel seeks time to get instructions.

Adjourned to 19.02.2025.”

3. Mr. Raman Sharma, Addl. A.G., Haryana submits that petitioner belongs to general category though he is a physically challenged person. There were two seats meant for physically challenged persons, one was meant for general category and another for scheduled caste category. Seat meant for



general category stands occupied and petitioner cannot be allotted seat meant for reserved category.

4. There seems no infirmity in the action of the respondent warranting interference.
