1. Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.PC seeking directions to respondent Nos.2 to 4 to conduct fair and impartial investigation in case FIR No.103 dated 04.08.2023 under Sections 307/323/341/148/149 of IPC, 1860 (Section 302 of IPC was added later on) registered at Police Station Sadar Sangrur, District Sangrur.

2. On 21.01.2025, the following order was passed by this Court:-

*Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that statement of deceased husband of the petitioner has been recorded by the Investigating Officer, but the same has been removed to help the accused in the present case and deceased husband of the petitioner has named 14-15 persons and jurisdictional police authorities have challaned only 08 persons and declared some of the accused as innocent.*

*Learned State counsel has produced the vernacular of the statement of deceased-Sikander in compliance of order dated 22.05.2024 passed by Co-ordinate Bench of this Court and seeks a*

*short accommodation to file a specific affidavit whether the statement of deceased-husband of the petitioner recorded under Section 161 Cr.P.C. is part of the official record or not and also to submit true translated copy of his statement along with copy of final report.*

*Adjourned to 31.01.2025.”*

3. In compliance of the previous order, status report dated 30.01.2025 has been filed by the State by way of affidavit of Mr. Sanjeev Singla, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Crime against Women & Children, Sangrur which is taken on record. Copy of the same has been supplied to the counsel for the petitioner.

4. Learned State counsel refers to para No.4 of the status report and submits that statement of Sikandar Singh (now deceased) was recorded on 04.08.2023 and a copy thereof is annexed with the status report as Annexure R-1/T and this statement is also the part of the final report dated 23.10.2023 submitted under Section 173 Cr.PC and the same is duly listed in the list of papers attached with the final report. He further submits that now at this stage case is fixed for recording of prosecution evidence, as such, nothing survives in the present petition.

5. In view of the specific stand taken by the State as stated in the short reply that statement of Sikandar Singh (now deceased) was recorded and same is part of the final report submitted on 23.10.2023, learned counsel for the petitioner requested to withdraw the present petition.

6. Accordingly, the present petition stands dismissed as withdrawn.
