1. By way of present appeal, appellant has challenged the order dated 24.12.2024, passed by learned Addl. Sessions Judge, Malerkotla, vide which, application of the appellant for seeking grant of regular bail petition in case FIR No.196, dated 06.12.2024, under Section 351(3) of BNS, 2023 and Section 3(1) the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989, registered at Police Station Amargarh, District Malerkotla, has been dismissed.
