Learned counsel for the parties submit that they have already compromised the issue hence, the order which has been passed by the authorities under Maintenance and Welfare of Parents and Senior Citizens Act, 2007 (hereinafter referred to as '2007 Act'), be not given effect to and the parties will live harmoniously with each other.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of respondent No.3 does not controvert the same and submits that now, the senior citizen, will live wherever he intends to i.e. with his surviving son who is also living in the same property concerned or with the daughter-in-law and grand-sons of other son who unfortunately expired, in the property concerned and that too harmoniously without creating trouble for anyone and he will not execute the impugned orders passed by the authorities under 2007 Act.
